Claremont completes Shoosmiths fit-out

Warrington-based Claremont Group Interiors has completed the design, fit-out and furnishing of law firm Shoosmiths' Manchester office at 3 Hardman Street in Spinningfields.

Claremont, which had already completed projects for Halliwells LLP, Ecclesiastical Insurance and BDO at the Allied London scheme, provided complete fit-out for the 9,925 sq ft office, which provides space for around 60 staff.

The firm had also worked on Shoosmiths' offices in Fareham, Reading and Nottingham. The generic design theme used on all three offices was continued at the Manchester office, with an open plan office and a curved glass wall feature. To add a Manchester-centric look-and-feel to the office, imagery of Dennis Law and Oasis appears on a row of glass walls.

Carol Light, firmwide facilities manager for Shoosmiths, said: "Claremont has very quickly grasped what Shoosmiths is all about - our culture, ethos and brand - and that manifests itself in the work it has done for us."
